Find the clocks in the house, what is the biggest number you can read on the clock? What number is the hand pointing to?

Find 5 pairs of socks hide 4 socks how many are left?

Ask your grown up to blind fold you. Listen to their instructions and see where you end up!

Look at a ruler, notice that the numbers get bigger one way and smaller the other way.

Make a number line, leave out numbers for children to complete.
