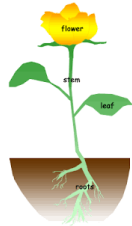

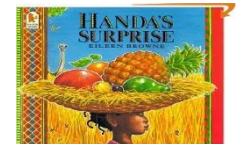

a-e (make), e-e (these), i-e (like), o-e (home), u-e (rule)

Some of these sounds have alternative pronunciations in some words so some words need to be tried out to find the correct one.
