Dear Parents,

Sports Morning Update – 9.30am Friday 6th July

As you are aware, sports morning is scheduled to take place at 9.30am this Friday, 6th July. Many thanks for your support in providing a coloured t-shirt for your child.

This year, we would like the children to come to school on Friday morning already dressed in their sports kit to enable a more efficient start to the day. They will need to be wearing their **coloured t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls/trainers, socks and sun hat** and should also bring a sweatshirt/cardigan. These will all be sent home beforehand in preparation. The children will stay in their sports kit for the remainder of the day on Friday so there is no need to send their normal uniform to school. It is also important that the children bring in a bottle of water and that sun screen is applied before they come to school.

The current forecast for Friday indicates that the warm weather will continue, but may be slightly cooler. We will be providing shade for the children so they will not be sitting in direct sunshine during the event. Some forecasts are indicating there may be the risk of thunderstorms this week. If there is rain during Thursday night and/or it is raining on Friday morning we will need to ensure it is safe to run the event. If this is the case, we will review the situation on Friday morning and if we have to postpone sports morning we will send a text to parents as soon as practicable which will state Sports Morning OFF. If the event cannot take place on Friday we will try to run it on Friday 13th July from 9.30am but again this will be weather permitting.

We will leave the tennis club gates unlocked during the event on Friday to allow parents to access the school from Southcote Park. Please would you ensure that the gates are kept closed at all times as one year a dog being walked in the park managed to get onto the school field as the gates had been left open. Thank you.

For the safety of your child, please do not take them away from their class during the event.

If required, visitor toilets will be accessible through the hall 'lettings' door – younger children who may be watching the event can use Cherry class toilets and adults can use the Hall toilet.
