

## Book recommendations for Year 2 Children to share with Parents at home.




Lighthouse Keeper's lunch by Ronda & David Amitage

A great book with excellent vocabulary which can be discussed & used as a dictionary quiz.




Tiddler by Julia Donaldson Reminder about rhyming words & phrases also look for hidden Gruffalo illustration in the text.




The Egg by M. P. Robertson

A super tale about how an egg is found and a dragon appears. Super starting point for creative writing.




Into the forest by Anthony Browne

Book of mystery and intrigue and links to fairy tales, can they spot the links?




Flat Stanley by Jeff Brown
