Know signs &lt; less than &gt; greater than Mental addition and subtraction. <u>Topics</u> <u>* Find numbers quickly on a 100 square</u> <u>*Partitioning 2 digit numbers</u> (e.g. 28 = 20+8) <u>* 2 digit addition and subtraction</u> (e.g. 75 +21) <u>*Revision of 2D and 3D shape - naming and describing properties e.g. this shape has 4 equal sides</u> <u>* Money - finding totals to £1 and over</u></p>	<p><u>Materials</u> These are some of the aspects we will cover:  <u>*To name materials</u> <u>* To sort and classify materials</u> <u>* To describe their properties</u> <u>* To know which materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching</u> <u>* To identify why materials have particular uses.</u></p>
