Administration of the Governing Body

Operational Business

Strategic Business

The Governors discussed the recent Schools Bill which included an increase to a 32 ½ hour school week for all schools. There were a number of reasons, including financial, which would have made the increase to our school week challenging. Further liaison with the Headteacher has acknowledged that this decision can be deferred as the Schools Bill has been halted. The Governing Body will continue to monitor this situation; however, it is unlikely to change before the next election which may result in further organisational changes!
