

### THE CHRISTMAS PLAY

We feel it is important to provide the children with the opportunity to perform in front of a live audience and are pleased to let you know that this year our Christmas play is a whole school production entitled "It's a Baby".

We are planning to run three performances on the following dates:

Performance 1: Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December at 1.30pm
Performance 2: Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> December at 9.30am
Performance 3: Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> December at 9.30am



Please be aware that the performances are for **adults only** and we are unable to accommodate any children in the audience.

Initially, we are having to restrict tickets to **two adults per family** due to the seating capacity in the hall. An additional adult ticket per family may be available and we will do our best to accommodate all requests for additional tickets.

## **Tickets**

A ticket request form will be sent home in your child's book bag today which we ask you to complete and return by Monday 27<sup>th</sup> November. Please note the following information:

- Unfortunately, we may not be able to offer all adults their preferred choice of performance so please indicate on the form a first and second preference for each adult. Please be aware that adults from the same family may not be offered the same performance as each other if we find that we have reached our ticketing capacity.
- As this is always a popular event, we do ask that if for any reason you are not able to use
  your tickets, you kindly return them to the school office. Please do not swop tickets
  with other parents as the office needs to keep an accurate record of numbers for each
  performance for health and safety reasons.
- Please ensure your child/children's name/s are on the form and you read the important information about photography and videos attached and tick the box on the ticket request form. Tickets cannot be issued until you have indicated on the form that you have read the Photography and Video guidance.
- Entrance to all performances will be by TICKET ONLY please remember to bring your tickets with you.

All tickets will be issued by Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> December and will be sent home in children's book bags. Parents will be notified by ParentMail on the day they are issued.

If you require seating for a disabled visitor at any of the performances, please indicate this on the ticket request form or contact the school office.

# **Christmas Play Costumes**

Letters will be sent home from the class teachers on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> November asking you for items of clothing for your child's costume. Please can you ensure that the items are brought into school in a named plastic bag by **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December**. Thank you in advance for your help with costumes; it is very much appreciated.



#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION - Photography and Videos**

Concerns about the use of photographic images of children have led to very clear guidance being issued by Surrey County Council relating to photography and videoing at school events. Please see the attached guidance on the use of photography and videos at Prior Heath events.
