Christmas Reminders

Further to the Christmas newsletter of 9th November, the following information provides reminders about events taking place before the end of term:

Christmas Play

The Christmas play this year is a whole school production entitled "It's a Baby" which is being performed on Monday 11th December at 1.30pm, Tuesday 12th December at 9.30am and Wednesday 13th December at 9.30am.

Ticket request forms have been sent home in book bags and should have been returned to the office by 27th November. Tickets will be sent home in children's book bags by Thursday 7th December at the latest. We are able to allocate two tickets per family across the three performances and hope to be able to provide the majority of parents with their first preference performance. However, please be aware that currently the performance on Monday 11th is very popular. Where we can, we will issue additional tickets but we will not be able to accommodate every request.

Entrance to all performances will be by TICKET ONLY - please remember to bring your tickets with you.

Christmas Play Costumes

Further to the information from your child's class teacher, please note the following regarding Christmas play costumes:

Year 1 and Year 2 children will need to bring their costumes into school in a named carrier bag by Monday 4th December. The costumes will remain in school until the final performance day.

Reception children will need to bring their play costumes into school in a named carrier bag on Monday 4th December to be checked. The costumes will then be sent home on Monday 4th. Reception children will then need to wear their costumes to school on Friday 8th December (for the dress rehearsal) and on Monday 11th, Tuesday 12th and Wednesday 13th December (for the performances).

Christmas Post Box

As in previous years, there will be a Christmas post box in each class during the week of 4th December. Please ensure that each envelope has the recipient's FULL NAME. This will be a great help when sorting cards and ensure that they are not accidentally given out to the wrong children. Last day for posting will be Friday 8th December.

On Thursday 7th December we will be taking part in Save the Children's Christmas Jumper Day. We're asking for a £1 donation for the charity in return for the children wearing home clothes to school, which includes a Christmas jumper/dress. If this is one of your child's PE days, please ensure that their clothes are suitable for taking part in PE and that they also wear their trainers to school.

The school Christmas lunch is also on Thursday 7th December. We try to make the hall and tables as festive as possible and an enjoyable occasion for the children. Registration for September 2024

Just a reminder that if you have a child who is five between 1st September 2024 and 31st August 2025 inclusive, or you have a child currently in Year 2, all admissions applications for Reception and Year 3 places for September 2024 need to be received by Surrey County Council by **15**th **January 2024**.

The Surrey Admissions team have asked us to advise you that applications received after the closing date, without good reason, will be treated as late and will not be considered until all on time applications have been processed. This may jeopardise the chance of parents being offered one of their preferred schools for their child.
